10.12 The following key points were discussed during the meeting:

- The University Nominee inquired about the staff-student ratio maintained at the institution. The Principal responded that the current ratio is 1:17, which is well above the minimum requirement of 1:20 as stipulated by Anna University.
- The University Nominee expressed concern regarding the low number of students eligible for placement. The Principal clarified that many companies set eligibility criteria ranging from 60% to 70% aggregate marks from 10th grade onwards. However, admissions are made based on the University norms, which allow students with scores below 60%. As a result, the number of eligible students for placement is lower.
- The Nominee requested the Principal to present details of student internships. He also enquired whether students are being adequately informed about internship advertisements, placement opportunities, and higher education options.
- The University Nominee asked for a report on the outcomes and benefits derived from signed Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs).
- The Nominee further queried the number of student ideas submitted under the Smart India Hackathon (SIH).
- State Government Nominee Dr. Sundaravaanan asked whether Honours and Minor degrees are offered to students. The Principal stated that these options are included in the academic regulations; however, students have shown limited interest in pursuing them.
- Dr. Srinivasan suggested introducing one or two practical-based courses among the six courses required for Honours/Minors to make them more appealing to students.
- The State Government Nominee also inquired about the institution's participation in the 'Niral Thiruvizha' event.
- The Industry Nominee informed that students generally lack the skill sets expected by industry recruiters. She recommended introducing an "AI Appreciation" course to enhance students' understanding and application of Artificial Intelligence in practical contexts.
- The Governing Body members made the following recommendations for institutional improvement:

- Enhance the number of publications in high-impact Q1 and Q2 journals.
- Improve placement outcomes, particularly by increasing the median salary of placed students.
- Strengthen collaboration and engagement with external institutions and industries to boost peer perception.
- Enhance activities conducted through the Centre of Excellence.
