The following suggestions were given by the Governing body members 6.12 The following are the discussions held in the meeting

- University Nominee Dr S Srinivasan enquired about Girls common room and Boys Common Room
- 2. Also, he raised query about the conduction and interest shown by students for B.E. (Hons) and B.E. (Minor) Degree programme
- 3. State Government Nominee Dr S.Gopi, raised clarification about the Internal Compliance Committee (ICC) and its activities.
- 4. Dr S Gopi raised clarification on Value added courses been conducted and asked to mention about the number of students who had successfully completed the courses offered in each branch and insisted to incorporate the same in the coming Governing body meetings. Principal replied that all the students in each department take up the Value added course and complete the assessment given on value added course in each semester.
- 5. Dr S Gopi asked for the details of UMIS registration of students in UMIS portal, 7.5% Govt admission count, PMSS Scheme, Pudhumaipen and FG status of the institution. Principal replied that around 570 students in First Graduation, 83 students in 7.5% Govt admission, 39 students in Pudumaipen scheme and 367 students in PMS scheme have registered and getting benefited.
- 6. Also clarified on MoU activities and suggested to map its outcome for student's employability. Principal replied that out of 15 MoUs signed with industries; around 20 activities were conducted during this semester and it is mapped with relevant course outcomes.
- 7. Dr S Gopi suggested to map the non-placed students either with the Higher studies or with entrepreneurial development and outcome is to be measured
- 8. Also, raised clarification about the guidelines of conduction of Working Professional courses
- 9. Dr S Gopi insisted on consultancy projects in all the branches of Engineering apart from Civil Engineering.
